GOLF REGULATIONS & GENERAL INFORMATION

Risk Warning: PLEASE NOTE

Golf is a recreational activity that involves a risk of physical harm. Each participant in the game of golf engages in such activity at his or her own risk.

Etiquette

1. No one should move, talk or stand close to, or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
2. No player should play until the group in front is safely out of range.
3. Players whilst searching for a ball must allow other matches behind to play through. They should signal to the following group to play through. They must allow the group to play through unless that group indicates that the players may continue playing the hole.
4. Players who have incurred a penalty must immediately notify their marker of such infringement.
5. When the result of a hole has been determined, players should leave the green immediately and should not re-try their putts.
6. All players are to ensure they carry enough sand to repair divots and also repair pitch marks on the greens. Players must also rake bunkers correctly and leave the bunker by the back or side where appropriate.
7. It is the responsibility of the lowest marker in any competition match to see that the above points are observed at all times.

STARTER &/OR COURSE MARSHALL

The Starter is responsible for organising play on all competition days. At times the starter may have to rearrange groups to allow the fields to keep moving and to take into consideration players who may otherwise miss out on playing.

All players are required to report to the Starter at least **20 minutes prior** to their scheduled hit off time. Players not ready to commence play when called to the tee by the Starter may be moved elsewhere in the field.

SLOW PLAY

Play should always be without undue delay. The objective for all players is to complete 18 holes in under 4¼ hours. This, of course, will depend on several variables such as weather/course conditions, type of competition [stroke, par, stableford] size of field etc. etc. We simply ask that players be aware of slow play and make every effort to keep up with the group in front at all times. Lets ALL have an enjoyable day!!

GOLF CARTS - PROOF OF INSURANCE

Privately owned and suitably sized motorised personal transport is allowed in all competitions including Championships. However, written permission must be obtained from Breakers Country Club to do so prior to use on the course. During wet weather other restrictions may be placed on the use of carts.

MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones must be programmed to meeting or silent mode when playing in competitions. If a phone needs to be left on for emergency purposes the Pro Shop must be advised of this requirement but must also be left in silent mode.

MATCH COMMITTEE

The Match Committee will be responsible for selection of all Pennant teams from players who nominate. They will also be responsible for compilation of the Fixtures Book.

HOME CLUB

A player's sole official handicap shall be allocated by the Home Club and, if such person becomes a full playing member of more than one Club, such player will be required to nominate their Home Club and advise such Club / Handicapper of their decision together with any other Club membership they may hold.

N.B. Where membership of other Golfink Clubs are held only one Golfink card [that of the Home Club] is to be current.

Non members are ineligible to win championship events or monthly medal.

COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

TIME SHEETS & BOOKING PROCEDURES

All players are required to use the computer booking system located both in the Pro Shop or outside the Golf Office within the main building. Competition bookings are available from 5.00pm on Friday afternoons two weeks prior to each competition day. Bookings are made by placing your Golfink card in the box located outside Golf Office prior to 5.00pm. A draw of all cards will be made from 5.00pm which then allows all card holders involved to access the computer booking system and may book one time slot with up to four players for each day involved. Online bookings available after 12 midnight the following Monday.

Alterations, amendments, new bookings etc. may be arranged at anytime after the above procedures have been completed.

Cancellation of bookings must be done as soon as possible through the computer system or through the Pro Shop. **If the cancellation is on the day of the competition it must be done through the Pro Shop at least 30 minutes before the allotted booking time.** If a member fails to cancel a booking on 2 or more occasions during any 12 month period, disciplinary action may be taken.

CARD RETURN

Competitors are responsible for ensuring both marker and player signatures are recorded as well as confirming correct handicap is shown on their cards prior to returning them. Players are responsible for correctly entering all results in the computer including NCR's & DNF's. * Ensure that card agrees with computer display. Cards should then be either given to

those responsible for compiling the results or placed in the box outside the Golf Office within **15 minutes** after play is completed or disqualification may result.

GRADES & HANDICAPS - INDIVIDUAL

Championship handicaps may differ at discretion of the committee and will be advised prior to competition.

FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIPS

½ of combined aggregate handicaps

AMBROSE

2 players ¼ combined aggregate handicaps

3 players 1/6 combined aggregate handicaps

4 players 1/8 combined aggregate handicaps

COUNTBACKS [Other than Championships]

18 Hole Events

The best score for the last 9 holes; if still tied, the last 6 holes; if still tied, the last 3 holes. If a tie persists, then hole by hole from the 18th.

27,36,54 & 72 hole Events

The last 18 holes shall be used and, if still tied the 18 hole events system will be used.

NB. The relevant handicap or fraction thereof shall be applied in all handicap event countbacks.

COMPLAINTS/DISPUTES

Competition issues should initially be addressed to the Captain or, if unavailable, the Starter for directions as to further procedure on a case by case basis.

PLAYING RULES - SPECIAL EVENTS

AMBROSE

Each player must use at least 3 of their tee shots in a 4 person and 6 in a 2 person event. The scorers must record this information on the card.

On the fairway, the original position of the selected ball is marked then each player may place their ball within 1 club length of the marker, no nearer the hole.

Off the fairway, the position of the selected ball is marked then the playing partner/s drop their ball within one (1) club length of the marked ball no nearer the hole. The drop to be in the same conditions as the selected ball, i.e. hazard, rough, bunker etc.

On the putting green, the selected ball is marked and all other balls putted from within 1 putter head length either side of the marker no nearer the hole. Players may choose to tap in putts after marking their balls position.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES

Both players have tee shots at each hole then play their second shots with their partner's ball. A ball is then selected and the owner of such ball plays the third shot. Play then continues as a foursome. Penalties or playing a provisional ball does not effect order of play. H/C calculated $\frac{3}{8}$ th's.

CANADIAN FOURSOMES

Both players play tee shots. A best ball is then selected and play proceeds as a foursome, the second shot played by the partner of that ball's owner. Again, penalties, or taking a provisional ball, do not affect order of play.

TEAM OF 4 STABLEFORD (2BBB)

Best 2 scores on each hole are counted and totalled.

TEAM OF 4 STABLEFORD - 1X2X3.

Type 'A' - Best score for each of the first 6 holes, best 2 scores for next 6 holes and 3 best scores on last 6 holes.

GROUP BB SPLIT 6

First 6 holes played as Best Ball, next 6 as Aggregate and last 6 as Multiplier.

ANNUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS, TERRIGAL CUP & COMPETITIONS

MEMBERS MEDAL OF MEDALS - SUNDAYS & TUESDAYS

A monthly Medal will be contested in Grades every month. All Net Grade winners will contest the Medal of Medals in October with prizes allocated for the Winners & Runners Ups.

MEMBER'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Singles and Juniors - 72 Holes Stroke & Net
Veterans - 54 Holes Stroke & Net
Foursomes - 27 Holes Stroke & Net

In order to qualify in a major championship event, players are required to have played at least three [3] handicapping competition games at Breakers during the previous 12 month period of the event being played.

All handicaps at the start of these events will remain static throughout that event but can be varied for the day's event.

FOURSOMES EVENT

A match in which two players play against 2 other players and each side plays the ball hitting alternate shots. Also teeing off on alternate holes with the player themselves alternating their tee shots from hole to hole.

The Bill Birch Knockout is an extra knockout comp over 5 x 1 month games of single stableford on Sundays & Tuesdays.

PLAY-OFFS IN CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

In cases of ties, in Championship events the following will apply;

[1] SCRATCH - Play-off over Holes 1 - 2 - 3 - 8 - 9 in sudden death format.

[2] NETT - Countback over 18-27-36-54-72 holes.

ECLECTIC COMPETITIONS

These competitions will be conducted on both Sundays and Tuesdays commencing on the March Medal Days and will run for 8 months concluding on the October Medal Rounds. All competitions BEST scores for each hole will be recorded by the Committee. Trophies will be awarded for both Scratch and Net Winners & Runners Up for both Tuesdays and Sundays using half final handicap.

All players eligible.

GEOFF & BILL KING TROPHY

An individual stableford event conducted in conjunction with the normal Tuesday event and run over 5 consecutive months from March through to July. Each player's best 3 stableford scores will be totalled to determine the overall winner of the event.

EAGLES NEST (Breakers Mens Golf Club)

Members only, starting with 6 golf balls and conducted during Tuesday and Sunday competitions. Competed for on 4th/13th hole, the aim is to achieve a shot within 60cm of the hole off the tee. Each week that the competition is not won, the Nest jackpots by one ball to a maximum of 24 balls. Any balls over this number go towards the next Nest. Hole in one receive a voucher, recognition on the honour board & eagles nest prize.

BREAKERS GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

Check the Local Rules on the Pro Shop board and on the back of the score card.

Visitors are required to produce their valid Golfink and home club membership card before being permitted to play in competitions and must ensure that the name of their Club is shown on their scorecard.

A maximum of 4 players per group and/or a maximum of 2 juniors in any competing group of four unless otherwise approved.

Players are to be suitably attired as determined by the Board from time to time. Shoes must have soft spikes. (Refer to Notice on Pro Shop wall)

Coloured flags denotes pin position on each hole, Black/White Check-Front, Red/White Check-Middle, Black/Gold Check-Back.

New members who have submitted three cards for handicap purposes will be given an official handicap but may come under revision after playing in five more competition rounds.

All roadways on the course are to be treated as GUR with approval of the marker. All approaches and exits to bridges have timber borders and are to be regarded as GUR as is the footpath/roadway running from the 8th tee bridge and running on the left hand side of Ladies 8th tee to the next bridge. Concrete footpaths on 1st, 2nd, 7th and 9th Holes are also GUR. To avoid possible injury there are patches of "Blue Metal" on the course which are also to be treated as GUR obstructions. All mulched areas are in integral part of the course unless otherwise signposted.

DAILY FEES

TEE BOOKINGS

Tee times need to be booked on computer, and are open two weeks ahead for most events. Access via the computer kiosks near the golf office and in the pro shop will be available from 12pm, with access on the Web Portal from 4pm. ALL players MUST report to the starter ready to play 20 minutes before their starting time. If unable to play, players MUST notify the starter prior to the start of that day's play. The starter has control over dispatch of the field.

CANCELLATIONS

A player who cancels on the day is not eligible to play in the event from which they cancelled.

LATE ARRIVALS

Players not ready to start when called by the starter may be moved to the end of the field (or elsewhere at the discretion of the starter) or not allowed to start.

PLAYERS WITHOUT A BOOKING

Visitors' names may not be entered until Monday pm preceding play or at discretion of the captain.

Players cannot participate in Thursday Competitions to return cards to gain handicaps. It is the **RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL PLAYER** to do this.

DRESS REGULATIONS

Permitted: Tailored slacks, shorts, skorts, skirts and shirts with collars.

Not Permitted: track suits, singlet tops, sun tops, washed out or denim jeans, abbreviated shorts or skirts.

MATCH COMMITTEE

The Match Committee will be responsible for the selection of all Interclub teams from players who nominate. They are also responsible for the compilation of the Fixtures Book. The program is subject to change at their discretion.

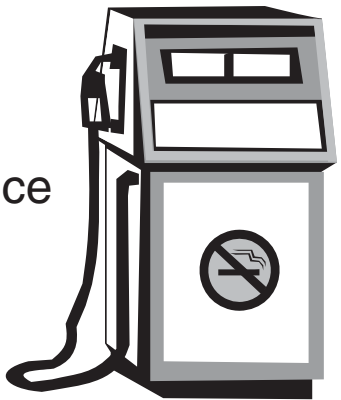
