



**Revocation of Exemption under the *Public Health (COVID-19 Temporary Movement and Gathering Restrictions) Order 2021* under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)***

I, Brad Hazzard, Minister for Health and Medical Research, under clause 25 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Temporary Movement and Gathering Restrictions) Order 2021* (Order) and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1987* hereby:

- 1) revoke the exemption made on 1 July 2021 and annexed to this instrument with effect from 5 pm on 9 July; and
- 2) hereby grant the following exemptions to that Order to take effect at 5.01 pm on 9 July:
  - a. Despite clause 23 of the Order, a person can participate in an outdoor public gathering in Greater Sydney for the purposes of an organised outdoor golfing event of more than 2 people subject to the following conditions:
    - i. There must be an nominated organiser of the event,
    - ii. The organiser of the event must ensure that all participants of the event are allocated to a group of individuals with each group consisting of no more than 2 persons,
    - iii. Each participant must take reasonably practicable steps to remain 1.5 metres from other persons (other than in emergencies),
    - iv. The organiser and each participant must take reasonably practicable steps to ensure that the individual allocated groups do not interact with one another,
    - v. The organiser and each participant must take reasonably practicable steps to remain outdoors at all times, and
    - vi. Each participant must provide their contact details (name and phone number) to the organiser,
    - vii. The organiser must take reasonably practicable steps to collect the contact details (name and phone number) of each participant and must keep a copy of the contact details for 28 days,
    - viii. The organiser must provide a copy of the participants' contact details (name and phone number) on request of a member of staff of NSW Health, and
    - ix. No spectators are permitted to participate in the gathering.
  - b. Despite clause 20 of the Order, a person can leave their place of residence to participate in an outdoor golfing event that complies with clause 2(a) of this exemption.

**Note: all other requirements of the Order must continue to be complied with, including exercising in a person's local government area or no further than 10 kilometers from a person's home.**

  - i. No spectators are permitted to participate in the gathering.
  
- 2) Despite clause 20 of the Order, a person can leave their place of residence to participate in an outdoor golfing event that complies with clause 1 of this exemption.
